The density then is the mass divided by the volume: Thus the cube is NOT gold, since the density (5.0 g/cm<sup>3</sup>) is not the same as gold (19.3g/cm<sup>3</sup>). You tell the seller to take a hike. You might even notice that the density of pyrite (a.k.a. fool's gold) is 5.0 g/cm<sup>3</sup>. Luckily you are no fool and know about density!
