They absolutely had concepts akin to modern race/ethnicity, even if they weren't the specific type of cultural and “scientific” categories we have today.

Further evidence of this concept in ancient thinking about ethnic identity is how Greeks commonly described the culture of an ethnos as "ancestral" as in "the ancestral customs" or "the ancestral laws." That is, the culture is connected to the physical forbears of the group.
