How To Fix Damaged Drywall

Remove the Damaged Drywall Use a framing square to mark a perfect square on the wall around the damaged area. It doesn't matter how large the square is as long as it encompasses all damaged or cracked drywall. Using a utility knife, score along the outline to remove the drywall square with all damaged areas.

How to Repair Damaged Drywall | how-tos | DIY

Remove as much drywall as needed until you reach studs beyond both sides of the damaged area. Discard the drywall and remove all exposed drywall nails or screws. Install wood cleats against the studs on both sides of the opening to support the new drywall's vertical edges (Image 1). Use scrap wood such as 1x2 furring for smaller repairs.

Small Dents and Dings. Scrape away loose debris from the hole. Cover the hole or dent with fast-drying spackle to bring the spackle level with the drywall surface and let it dry 24 hours -- or the time recommended by the manufacturer's instructions. Sand smooth.

How to Patch and Repair Drywall - Lowe's

Before cutting out the damaged area of this how to fix drywall project, check the wall for obstructions. Often you'll find a wire, pipe or duct. If so, work carefully around them with a drywall or keyhole saw. Or make a shallow cut by repeatedly scoring the line with a sharp utility knife to begin a hole patch.

Drywall Repair: How to Patch a Hole in the Wall

Patching drywall requires you to cut a clean hole in the wall, cut a patch to fit, screw the patch into place on the wall and tape around the joint before mudding. It may seem counterintuitive to cut a bigger hole in the wall, but it is the only way to get a strong, smooth finish in the end.

Remove any screws or nails holding the drywall up and pull the damaged area free. Scrape off all damaged wall material surrounding the new hole and prime the whole area with a primer/sealer. Cut a new piece of drywall of the same thickness and fit it into the space. Match the edges of the patching piece to the surrounding drywall edges.

When first putting up drywall, you screw it in place, tape the seams, and cover them with joint compound. But the paper covering the entire sheet of drywall is typically not smooth.

If there was no stud behind I used the drywall knife to cut out damaged sections. If cuts were on a stud I used the utility knife to score the top paper of the dry wall. Then I used the hammer and multi-tool to chiseled down to the stud. I followed that with the utility knife again to make a nice clean edge.

Steps to Fix Damaged Drywall After Wallpaper Removal It is extremely important to make sure that you remove all the flue left behind by the wallpaper. Wash the walls with TSP and water, which will clear away dried glue globs and any other remnants. Make sure you give your walls a thorough rinse afterwards.

How to Fix Damaged Drywall from Wallpaper Removal

Depending on how much of the drywall suffered damage, you can either replace just the damaged sections, or you can replace the whole sheet. If your wall is sagging 3/8 inch or more, then the recommendation is that you replace the whole thing. Otherwise, you can cut out the damaged sections and replace it with a piece of new drywall.

Cut along the chalk line one half or three quarters of the way through the thickness of the drywall. Use a utility knife. Loosen and remove the damaged portion carefully. To make that easier, knock a small hole in the damaged drywall using a hammer.
